THE PINOT PROJECT

The Pinot Project began in 2009 with a vision: a wine for the palate, the pocket, and the people. Renowned wine importer, Michael Skurnik, brought this idea to life with his first production of a silky, well-balanced California Pinot Noir. The Pinot Project has since taken the wine world by storm! With a keen interest in the Veneto, The Pinot Project procured this crisp and quaffable Italian rosé.

THE JUICE

The grapes are harvested from the prestigious growing region of Veneto, Italy. They are then pressed, and the Pinot Grigio skins impart a lovely pink color due to an overnight cold temperature maceration. After the grape skins and must are removed, temperature-controlled fermentation occurs in stainless steel. The wine is completely unoaked to maintain freshness.

THE 2018 VINTAGE

Coming off a difficult vintage the previous year, the 2018 growing season was characterized by moderate temperatures and ideal weather conditions. These favorable elements led to great balance of sugar and acidity in the Pinot Grigio grapes. While the yields were lower at harvest, quality was high, indicating a terrific vintage ahead.

THE TASTING NOTES

Elegant, pale pink in color. On the nose, a fruity and floral bouquet of raspberries and rose petals. A harmonious wine with dry, crisp acidity and good structure. Lively on the palate, giving way to a long, seamless finish.
